


STATE OF THE STATE ADDRESS

- > Gov. Mike Parson delivered address Jan. 16, 2019
- > UM System requests \$416.8 million in core funding
 - > Continuance of core operations in FY19
 - > Up to \$72.5 million in new performance funding tied to current performance measures, new workforce development initiatives



> No cut to core at this time, must plan to address future gap

Without action, a \$150-200 million gap forms

FEDERAL SHUTDOWN UPDATE

- > OSP will continue to invoice federal agencies
- > Areas of risk:
 - New awards, renewals, supplements and continuation of funding will not be awarded during partial shutdown
 - Faculty and staff on review panels for an agency that is shut down should consider travel plans
 - Grant reporting obligations and deadlines remain in effect

FEDERAL SHUTDOWN UPDATE

- > Areas of risk (continued):
 - Agency proposal submission systems remain operational
 - Most deadlines remain in effect, but agencies will not review submitted proposals until normal operations resume
 - Pre-award/advance accounts may be requested from OSP, but investigators, chairs, deans and fiscal staff are advised that there is additional risk in spending funds prior to receipt of award
- > Direct shutdown-related correspondence from the sponsor (e.g., stop work orders) to um-research@umsystem.edu
