## **PURPOSE**

- · Reduce impact on environment with regard to water and air emissions and solid waste; and
- Continually improve our environmental stewardship with respect to materials, water and energy use.

The policy is a firm foundation for setting our environmental objectives and targets and this in turn will be evident in our daily activities.

## **POLICY**

- Missouri S&T will follow the guidelines of the American College & University Presidents Climate Commitment (ACUPCC) to reduce emissions of greenhouse gases.
- Missouri S&T will raise awareness among faculty, staff and students on the importance of proactive environmental management and stewardship.
- Missouri S&T will implement measures to conserve resources, including energy, water and paper.
- **Missouri S&T** will provide recycling and waste minimization opportunities, awareness, and education for campus and surrounding communities.
- Missouri S&T will establish continual improvement processes to prevent pollution and ensure compliance with regulatory and other requirements.
