



#### > Finance and Operations

Closed institutional research and assessment (IRA)
 office; redistributed duties to other units; other
 duties to be distributed to UM System offices

#### > Library

- Library structure under review
- Interim director serving, one position eliminated

#### > Student Affairs

- Closed office of professional leadership and campus engagement
- Reduced staffing in Leach Theatre

### ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES

#### > Global Learning

- Global learning structure under review, Faculty
   Advisory Council on Global Education created
- Acting vice provost of global learning named
- 31 positions (media producers and instructional technicians) transitioned from educational technology to IT
- 9 positions from Ed Tech remain in global learning in new department, instructional design and development

### ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES

- > Research, Sponsored Programs & Graduate Studies
  - Hired vice chancellor of research and dean of graduate studies (New position resulting from combining research and graduate studies departments in 2017)
  - Office of sponsored programs (OSP) under review, report due in September
- > University Advancement
  - Closed office of corporate relations, absorbed some operations in corporate development with greater leadership/engagement by research and CEC
